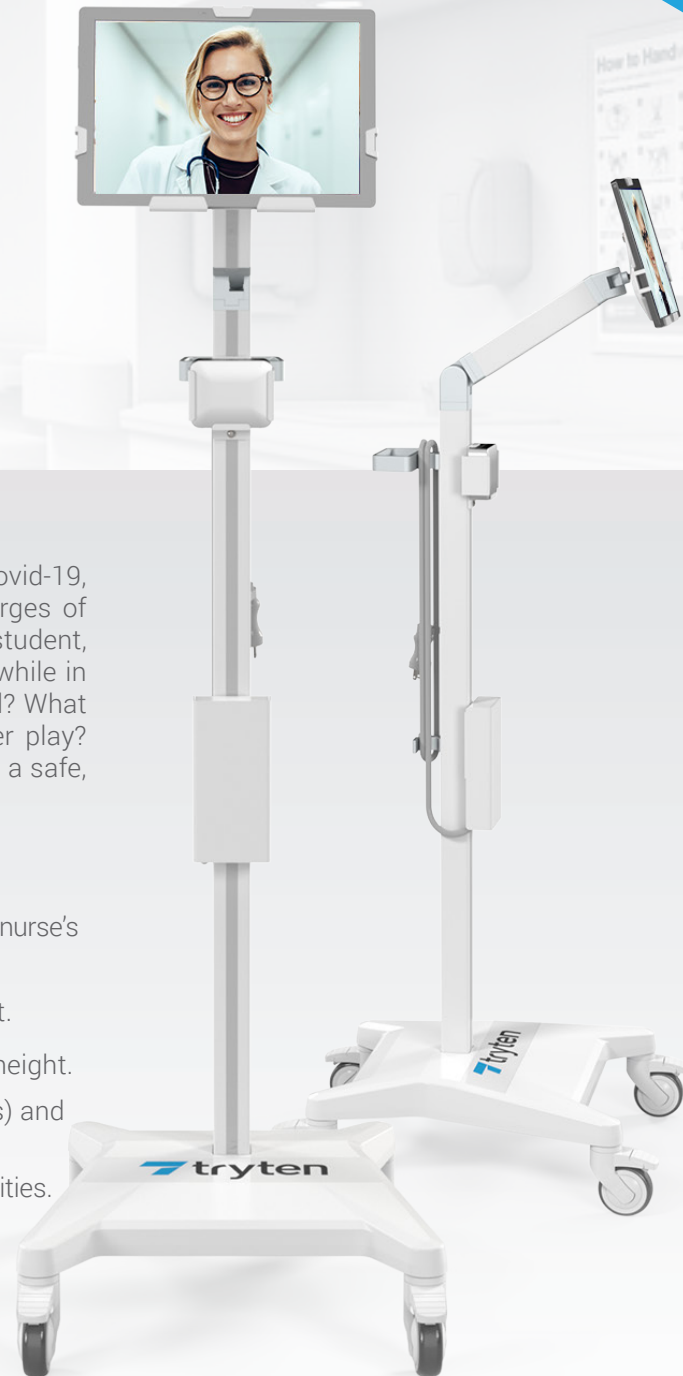




# Virtual Nursing Assistant



## Challenge

As schools enter the 2020/2021 school year in the shadow of Covid-19, they are preparing ways to mitigate the risk associated with surges of the virus.
